✓	Barbara Boxer is fighting to end tax breaks for companies that outsource jobs. <i>(The Wall Street Journal, 6/8/10)</i>	✗	Carly Fiorina calls off-shoring jobs "right-shoring" and says "there is no job that is America's God-given right anymore." <i>(San Francisco Chronicle, 1/9/04)</i>
✓	Boxer has fought to end wasteful contracting-out and privatization. She opposes any effort to privatize social security. <i>(Kennedy- Mikulski amendment to H.R. 1585. 10/1/07; Vote #123, FY 2010 Budget Resolution. 2/24/09)</i>	✗	Fiorina will continue giving tax breaks to companies that export jobs and supports the Bush tax giveaways for the wealthy. <i>(The San Diego Union-Tribune, 4/1/10; Americans for Tax Reform Pledge, 11/4/09)</i>
✓	Boxer supports fair pay and workers' rights. Supported collective bargaining rights for Transportation Security Officers and for the Employee Free Choice Act. <i>(S.
